- **Call to order at 7:32pm.**
- **Adoption of previous minutes by Karlee and Sarah**
- **Fundraising report.**
  - Focus on next year as this year is wrapped up
  - September will be Entertainment Books
  - Need 6-8 volunteers: To get books out the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of school
  - Incentives: Based on books sold K-2 3-5 6-7; also draws
  - More money raised will go to school, Mike, PAC
  - Book Goal: tiered system of monetary bonuses
  - Top Goal is \$13,000
  - October: Family Photo nights: \$20. For seating and then purchase further from there
  - November: Frozen foods, Purdy's, poinsettias
  - Looking for another fundraiser for Christmas
  - We will not be taking over the pre-ordered school supplies: PAC said NO: not enough money
  - Mabel's Label's: Account being setup to have it for the summer and then for back to school
- **Hot Lunch report.**
  - Friday the 15<sup>th</sup> is last hot lunch booked with Bread Garden
  - Looking into other options: kids are getting tired of BG
  - Hoping to have a September 2012 Hot Lunch
- **Principals report.**
  - Looking at over 900 kids next year
  - June is busy: gr.7 graduation, field trips, sports days
  - Organize classes by grade level: six grade one classes this year
  - Hard to organize by Friday
  - This fall was done with primary and intermediate
  - Intermediate may not be until the following week to know their classes/teachers
  - General review for STORM, math,etc.
  - Not able to store EDU-PAK not doing it next year: too much work for our population
  - Parents to support the school is the best way to help the school
  - School supply list is probably going out/posted on the website by end of June
  - The website will be changing over on August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012

- **Old Business.**
  - **Earthquake Prep**
    - Looked at cost for water, food, first aid kits
    - Offered to do awareness campaign and do a donation of the portion for our EQP kits
    - This is 1000 ppl for 72 hours time frame:
      - \$2,700 in chqs \$5,900 approx. in cash
    - Need to have information from Jen
    - FB page for EQP: if they like it back; or keep it;
    - Draft a letter asking parents what they would like to do with their money
    - Tabled until September
  - **Playground**
    - Mike showed the designs
    - Kids want twisty slide and swings
    - \$52,300 included swing Blue Imp still to give us the same pricing
    - Site prep: mike still connecting with the manager of grounds and mike's boss about paying for the site prep; and size of the site
    - PASSED: Blue Imp playground with swings
  - **Fun Fair**
    - Thank you to everyone.
    - Gr.1 are making thank you cards to the vendors
    - Pricesmart: donated all the food except for the ice cream cups: \$300.
    - Recycling: refunded for the liners
    - Cake Walk: Gr.7's changed music ; inappropriate music; parent volunteer left; lack of supervision.
    - Games: one parent found the carnival games pricey at 3 punches; thought it should be 2 punches
    - Need more hype at the Annex about the Fun Fair
    - Perhaps a sign at the Annex
    - Cotton Candy: Mrs. Ross is the CC lady but because of the JA the teacher couldn't do it
    - Frostings & Molly's Donuts: we're very happy
    - Photo Booth: it was a hit
    - Vendors were satisfied: even though it was inside
    - Because of the weather \$20,000:
    - We did \$21,541 this year.
