- Trialling new things to see how they go for variety
- Have volunteers but still need more to help
- No complaints about food & no issues/complaints with the ordering

## **Principals Report**

- Newsletter will start going out online tomorrow again: Hard copy will still be sent out this month
- Christmas concert went well: Risers were what students were standing on, need them for choir 50-60 kids: Alternate primary & intermediate for xmas concerts
  - We were able to get them supplied by the district because other schools cancelled their Christmas concert:
- An opportunity for cost sharing to go towards purchase of risers : money from Christmas concert will go to risers
  - If we store risers and light tree stands, we could reduce costs (cost sharing), all we would have to do is store and then we would have priority access to risers
  - We would have to lend them out but have first access to them
  - Also working on curtains for the gym/multipurpose room: will enclose part
    of the multipurpose room to make it like a stage- then we would have to
    rent a portable stage: to raise the kids up for fine arts performances
  - o Principal Mike will get back to us about what the cost split would be
  - Still to be determined where to store them.
- Smart Board installed for Barb: very appreciative and excited to use it
  - o Portable board is ordered but the cart is not ready for it yet

- Will be used alot by primary and intermediate teachers
- Leadership team students (Organized by Keely Yee & Jill Payne Teachers):
   fundraising for the food bank was successful over 3,000 items delivered
  - o Looking forward to spirit days i.e. pj day; twin day; wacky hair days
- Possible annual contest: Name that hurricane: which include 94 staff including crossing guards & staff
  - Pictures are displayed in the front lobby of main school and at the main lobby of annex
  - o The annex has 30 pictures: students to name 20 pictures out of 30
  - Gr.1 name 40; Gr.2 name 50; Gr.3 name 60: the persons entry that is drawn with the correct names will win lunch for the class
  - This encourages students to ask staff their names
- Kindergarten registration starts Monday January 16<sup>th</sup>: expecting a large turnout
  - o Increase will be estimated in the Spring
  - District will not make predictions about growth now
- New School: still waiting for a chq from treasury board for new school funding: nothing is started as of yet
  - PLEASE: Continue emailing to Kevin Falcon & Christy Clarke to raise attention about overcrowding issues
  - It takes 5 years to build a Secondary: Extended days may be implemented at Clayton Secondary in the future: Early start time for some grades and earlier for others. Which is the same number of students but better use of classroom space
  - There are 90 GR. 8's this year for the Secondary
  - Looking at a new school in the area instead of an addition: amalgamation of land further north of school: they do have an area that they want and work with the city to share plans: they have 3-4 more elementary schools that they want funding for but need the funding for
- Skip-a-thon: Spell-a-thon will not happen due to Job Action this year: as teachers cannot collect money
  - Collecting money for field trips & special events money collecting has been challenging
  - Our school is trying to make it happen with events & field trips
- Spinners in the playground: Tornados: are missing: What happened to them is: new
  distributor is not allowed to install equipment & had to take them out as the bolts
  were beginning to sheer: If fixed the warranty will be void: it has gone back to the
  manufacturer: will bring them back when they have the proper bolts that will not
  sheer
- We do have an area allotted for a new playground but because they announced the new school; we will not be priority to get a new playground

- Do we as parents want one by the crossing or by the gym? Consensus was to separate them. Bonus: it's should be less victimized by vandals
  - Want to not have a younger & older playground because want to keep from dividing the school. Alternating btw primary & intermediate on the playground for breaks.
  - Letter was sent to be reimbursed by the district for our playground : we were approved but the money has not yet been received
