- Treasurers Report
  - Robotics and Photography Club came out of gaming grant account: \$27, 368.81
  - Regular Bank Account: \$24, 298.58
- Principals Report
  - Emergency earthquake backpacks were purchased and will be labelled and placed in classrooms
  - Scholastic Book Fair was a huge success: sale about \$4,500 which is a \$3,000 profit back to the library
  - Music Teacher Patricia: Choir Festival sang two songs excellent focus, diction and memory
  - Grade 4 and 7's will go to Clayton Heights to perform for seniors
  - Upcoming events:
    - First people in residence: week to acknowledge aboriginal culture
    - This week April 9-13: every class received a workshop and there was an opening ceremony on Monday and another assembly on Friday
  - Photography group taking pictures of presenters this week
    - Students are very excited about the club
    - Grades 4 & 5's
  - Robotics/Coding Club
    - Very successful: 37 students showed up after Spring Break

- 28 Grade 5's: Students are challenging themselves and choosing their projects
    - 12 are returning after spring break and opened up to the Grade 4's
  - Ready, Set, Learn open to all preschools – announcement will go out soon
  - Dance Festival: 4 groups are going on April 24, 2018
  - Received out entitlement projections: 766 Student currently we have 755 students
  - Entitling us to 33 divisions next year
  - Space will be prepared in advance and that will be one more portable installed in the summer
  - Two new schools will be built in this area: one will offset Katzie and the year after will offset Hazelgrove
  - Teachers putting funding request forward Gaming Grant Money
    - Request for support for Math Club and then for the rest of the school: 10 new Chrome Books \$425./each \$4255.10: VOTED: Gaming Grant: account: APPROVED.
    - Request from Librarian: Start two Harry Potter Clubs for younger and older grades: quizzes, crafts, discussions about books: \$150/club: Total \$300.00 ex. Bookmarks, wands, etc. VOTED: Gaming Grant account: APPROVED.
    - Request for LST: Home reading books to get more books: \$500.00 VOTED: Regular account: APPROVED.
