- Fundraising Report
  - Vancouver Giants:
    - 156 approx. tickets sold
  - Question:

- Hot Lunch Report

- Treasurer's Report
  - Gaming \$47, 926.24:
  - Regular \$34, 691.22: invoice for chrome books, so balance will go down
- Principal's Report
